Ignition cut-out on Track Racing bike

For information

To all concerned

Due to the fact that the present new Track Racing Technical Rule 37.02 can be misinterpreted the Rule has been reworded by the CCP, CTI and Speedway GP Commission as below. The Rule will be in force with immediately effect.

Clarification of Track Racing Technical rule 01.37 Throttle Controls

37.02

An ignition cut-out switch must be fitted on the handlebar, as close as is practical to the throttle.

The switch must cut off the circuit of the electrical supply by the simple action of pulling, a non-elastic lanyard **as short as possible**, attached to the rider's right wrist. (Interrupting the electric supply by grounding the circuit, is not a sufficient measure).

Please co-operate in this matter so it allows the Technical Steward to perform his job with efficiency.
